

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRENADIAN PASSPORT

An applicant could choose to obtain his/her Citizenship Certificate and opt not to apply for a Grenadian passport. If the applicant decides to apply for a Grenadian passport, the application for a Grenadian Passport MUST be accompanied by the following:

- a. Completed Application for a Grenadian Passport signed by each applicant;
- b. Evidence that the prescribed fee has been paid. This is done through the local agent;
- c. Evidence that citizenship of Grenada has been attained through investment- original of the Citizenship Certificate;
- d. Marriage Certificate or Divorce Certificate (where applicable);
- e. If the applicant has changed his or her name, registered Birth Certificate or Deed Poll recording the change must be submitted;
- f. Two (2) certified photographs. The size of the photographs must not be more than 2 ½ inches by 2 inches or less than 2 inches by 1 ½ inches. The photograph must be taken full face without hat or covered hair save for religious reasons and even then forehead and ears must be visible. The photographs must not be mounted. The photograph must be printed on normal thin photographic paper and must not be glazed on the reverse side.

Note:

1. Please read the requirements on the forms set out on page 1 carefully.
2. Passports are valid for five (5) years.
3. Applicants are not required to renounce any other citizenship.
4. For children under the age of 16 years, the parent(s) must sign section 11 of the Application for a Grenadian Passport on behalf of the minor child.
5. Consent of the parents is required to be given at section 9 for applications being made on behalf of children under 16. Where the father of a child is alive his consent is required, if the father is deceased or in the case of a child born out of wedlock, the mother's consent is required. Where the parents are deceased, the person who has legal custody must consent and provide proof of legal custody of the child.

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6. Section 12 of the Application for a Grenadian Passport has to be completed by a recommender. For these purposes, the Local Agent will sign as recommender.

7. The recommender may certify the two (2) passport pictures to accompany the application or they be certified by a notary public (or where unavailable an attorney-at law or medical doctor) who knows the identity of the person(s) in the picture by endorsing on the reverse side of the picture “I certify that this is a true likeness of the applicant (state name)” and affixing his/her signature thereafter. This is required for ALL applicants including minor children.
